



## New Zealand Residence Programme *Fortnightly Selection Statistics – 2 July 2008*

---

### 1. Selection 2 July 2008– Skilled Migrant Category

The most recent selection of Expressions of Interest (EOIs) under the Skilled Migrant Category took place on **2 July 2008**.

- **454** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **140** or above;
- **109** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **100** or more but less than 140, and included points for offers of skilled employment or current skilled employment in New Zealand.
- **47** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **100** or more but less than 140, and included 15 points for work experience in an area of absolute skill shortage.
- **34** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **100** or more but less than 140, and included 10 points for work experience in an area of absolute skill shortage.
- **52** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **100** or more but less than 140, and included 10 points for a qualification in an area of absolute skill shortage.
- **178** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **115** or more but less than 140. These EOIs did not claim points for offers of skilled employment or current skilled employment in New Zealand, work experience in an area of absolute skill shortage or for a qualification in an area of absolute skill shortage. These EOIs were ranked in descending order of points.

As a result, **874** EOIs representing **2046** people were selected and will now undergo preliminary verification to determine if an invitation to apply for residency will be issued.

### 2. The make-up of selection

Based on the information provided by people who had their EOIs selected, the make-up of the 2 July 2008 selection is as follows:

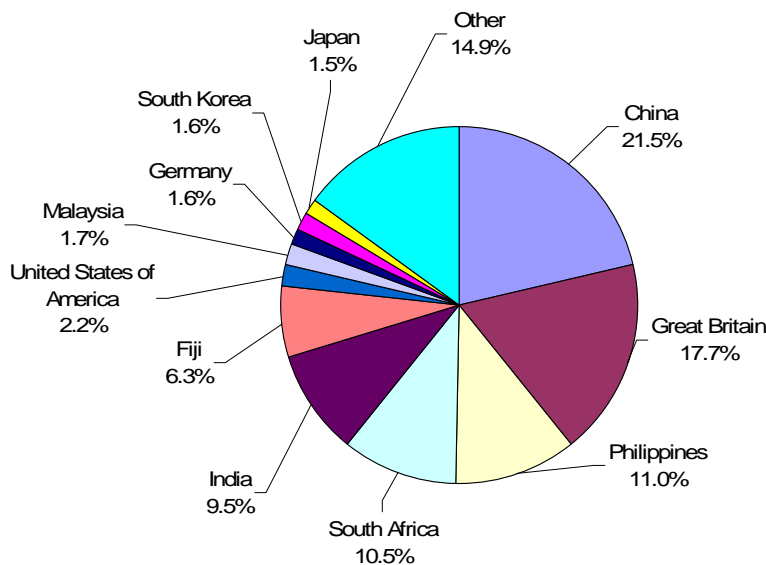

2 July 2008**

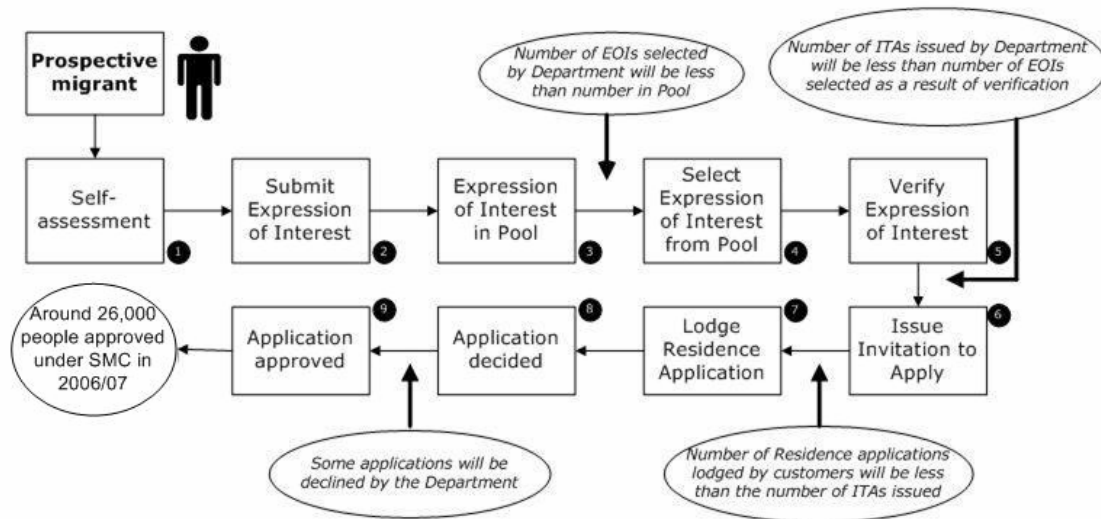


#### 4. Statistics since December 2003

Approximately **96 percent** of those EOIs selected have been verified (stage five below).
