Fortnightly Selection Statistics – 14 January 2009

1. Selection 14 January 2009– Skilled Migrant Category

The most recent selection of Expressions of Interest (EOIs) under the Skilled Migrant Category took place on **14 January 2009**

- **653** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **140** or above;
- **125** EOIs were selected that had a points total of **100** or more but less than 140, and included points for offers of skilled employment or current skilled employment in New Zealand.

As a result, **778** EOIs representing **1,850** people were selected and will now undergo preliminary verification to determine if an invitation to apply for residency will be issued.

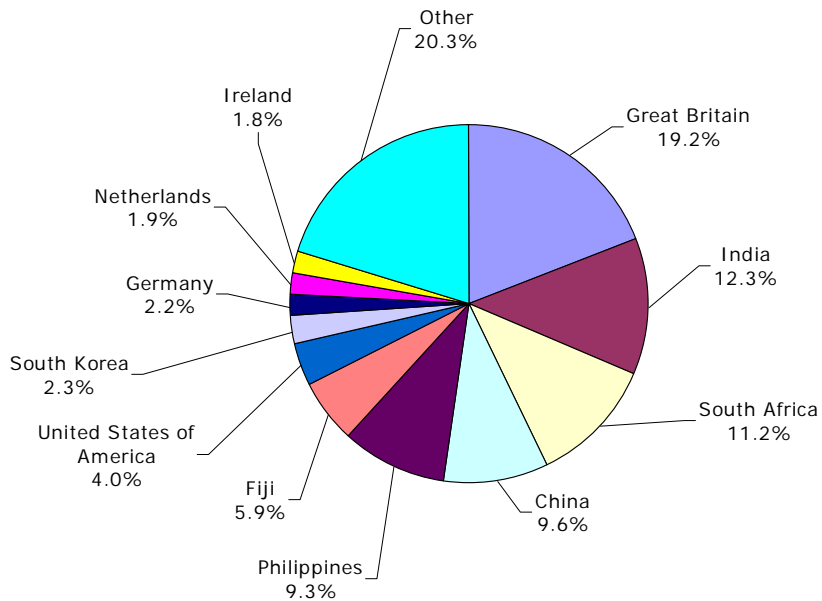
2. The make-up of selection

14 January 2009

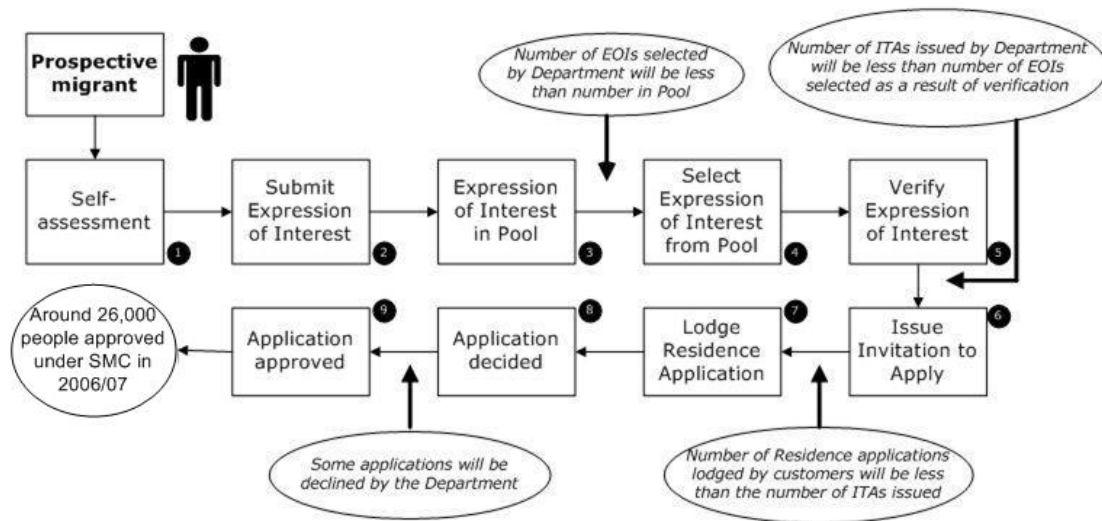


4. Statistics since December 2003

Since the Skilled Migrant Category opened in December 2003, a total of **92,276** EOIs, representing **214,992** people, have been selected

Approximately **96 percent** of those EOIs selected have been verified (stage five below).
